| Repentance                      | There are more terms of pardon than are mentioned in Luke 13:3, <i>"I tell you, no! But unless you repent, you too will all perish,"</i> but there never can be less.   | If the Bible says that we are saved <b>"BY REPENTANCE"</b> , that is true, but we cannot be saved by less.                        |
| Calling on the name of the Lord | There are more terms of pardon than are mentioned in Romans 10:13, <i>"Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved,"</i> but there never can be less.  | If the Bible says that we are saved <b>"BY CALLING UPON THE NAME OF THE LORD"</b> , that is true, but we cannot be saved by less. |
| •Baptism                        | There are more terms of pardon than are mentioned in Acts 2:38, <i>"Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins,"</i> but there never can be less. | If the Bible says that we are saved <b>"BY BAPTISM"</b> , that is true, but we cannot be saved by less.                           |
